## Play for Poland! - How do we process your data? (data information clause)

- 1. The Procesor of the personal data provided in the form is Polski Związek Koszykówki (Polish Basketball Association) with its seat in Warsaw at Siedmiogrodzka 9 (01-204 Warsaw), registration number in the National Court Register: 0000033466.
- 2. Providing personal data is voluntary, but is necessary to apply for the Player Candidate for the "Play for Poland!" program, including the presentation of his/her profile, sports conditions and experience.
- 3. The Procesor will process personal data to analyze the Player's candidacy and possible invitation of the Player to training or training camp to assess his/her sports level.
- 4. The Polish Basketball Association has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who can be contacted by e-mail at: iod@pzkosz.pl or the Procesor's address on matters related to the processing of personal data.
- 5. The recipients of your data and your child's data will be only entities authorized by law and contractors of the Polish Basketball Association who, in connection with the performance of services for us, will process personal data on our behalf based on contracts previously concluded with us.
- 6. We will store your data until the realization of the purpose for which the personal data was collected, but no longer than:
  - the issuance by PZKOSZ of an invitation for a Player to a training, training camp,
  - > or until you withdraw your consent to process the data contained in the form,
- 1. Individuals whose data is processed have the following rights:
- The right to access their data and to receive a copy of their data;
- The right to rectify (amend) their data;
- The right to withdraw consent, in a situation where the processing was based on consent;
- The right to the erasure of personal data, where the processing is not carried out to fulfil an obligation arising from a legal provision or in the exercise of public authority;
- The right to restrict data processing;
- The right to object to the processing of data;
- The right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (to the address of the Office for Personal Data Protection, 2 Stawki Street, 00-193 Warsaw).
- 1. Personal data will not be processed in an automated manner or be subject to profiling.
- 2. Personal data will not be transferred to third countries, outside the EEA zone.
